- Background playlist

Creating Your Playlists (Spotify)

Please create your music as separate playlists on Spotify, clearly labelled (for example, "Ceremony – Aisle Song" or "Wedding Breakfast Playlist").

To ensure we can access them easily, please make sure:

- All playlists are set to public
- Playlist names are clear and easy to search
